With reference to the subject quoted above, I have the honour to submit herewith the Report for the month of April, 2017 regarding compliance of the directions issued by the Honourable Supreme Court, for development of children, who are in jail with their mothers as follows :

On 27<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2017, I made inspection of the Distric Jail, Lakhimpur, North Lakhimpur, to monitor that the directions issued by the Honourable Supreme Court of India are being complied with, and during my visit, no child was found living with their incarcerated mothers. It is informed by the Jail authority that generally the children in jail with their mothers are provided with proper food, medical care, clothing, education and recreational facilities. No complaint from the female ward is received in this regard. There is no creche and nursery facility in this Jail.
