Item: Matter relating to ensure speedy justice to women, swift and time bound disbursement of maintenance to women by streamlining the process in this regard and to monitor speedy execution of warrants issued by the Courts in this respect.

The committee discussed the maneuver keeping all imminent perspectives in hand as to how the disposal of the cases under Sec. 125 of the Cr. P.C. pending in different Courts under the District Judiciary, Lakhimpur can be expeditiously disposed of so as to ensure justice to the victim-women, in concurrence with momentous actions to be taken for swift and time-bound disbursement of maintenance allowance granted to the victim-petitioners in such cases at the execution stage to save them and their children from looming vagrancy.

In the course of arriving at various generous decisions on this point in the earlier meeting of the Committee, submission of lists of maintenance cases pending for disposal and also at execution stage pending in all the subordinate Courts were made encoded, and in conformity to which the same have been submitted in separate statements showing the stage of pendency ending **February, 2019** as follows:-
