

MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON 07.06.2017 AT 4.00 PM IN THE OFFICIAL CHAMBER
OF THE DISTRICT & SESSIONS JUDGE, LAKHIMPUR, AT NORTH LAKHIMPUR.

A meeting has been convened today, the 7th day of June, 2017 in the official chamber of the District & Sessions Judge, Lakhimpur, at North Lakhimpur at 4.00 Pm under the chairmanship of the District & Sessions Judge, Lakhimpur, North Lakhimpur. This meeting has been convened to sort out the issues relating to delay in investigation and trial, in pursuance of the Order dtd. 05.08.2013 passed by the Honourable Gauhati High Court, in W.P.(C) (Taken-up) No.4299/2006.

The matter of pending cases in the Police Stations of the district of Lakhimpur beyond 90 days has been discussed. The Supdt. of Police, Lakhimpur, has informed that altogether 1452 nos. of cases are pending beyond 90 days in the Police Stations of Lakhimpur district up to May, 2017 out of which, 100 nos. of cases are pending in various Police Stations of Lakhimpur district due to non-submission of Injury Report/ Post Mortem Report. The Supdt. of Police, Lakhimpur, has also informed that the matter was already taken up with the Health Department of the district. It has also been informed that altogether 105 nos. of cases are pending in various Police Stations of Lakhimpur district due to non-handing over the Case Diaries by the respective Investigating Officers either due to their retirement or death, and necessary steps have already been taken in this regard for early disposal of the cases. It has further been informed that total 11 nos. of cases are pending in various Police Stations of Lakhimpur district due to non-receipt of prosecution sanction, and in this regard, a Screening Committee has already been formed, and steps being taken in this regard for the matter of approval. So, this committee has decided to wait for further report. The Supdt. of Police has also informed that 38 nos. of cases are pending in various Police Stations of Lakhimpur district due to non-receipt of FSL Report and 49 nos. of cases are pending due to non-recovery of the victims. The Supdt. of Police, Lakhimpur, has informed that steps being taken in this regard.

This Committee has requested the Supdt. of Police, Lakhimpur, to direct the Officer-in-charge of the Police Stations of the district to ensure that the full name and phone nos. of the Investigating Officers and Medical Officers are mentioned in the charge sheet. The Committee has also resolved that arrangement for separate storage of the seized articles under Narcotic Drugs & Pshycotropic Substance (NDPS) Act be made, and in this regard, the Deputy Commissioner and Superintendent of Police shall take necessary steps.

This Committee has decided to take necessary steps for uploading of this Report in the official website of the District & Sessions Judge, Lakhimpur, North Lakhimpur.

With these discussions, the meeting held today on 7th day of June, 2017, has been concluded with vote of thanks from the chairman.
